NOTIFICATION

It has been brought to my notice of the undersigned that in some persons are using Drone Cameras in Marriage Functions and other events in Rachakonda limits without obtaining permission by the Police Department and Director General of Civil Aviation Department, Govt. of India, which is against rules.

There is an increasing trend by event organizers to use remote controlled drones for getting aerial views for live telecasts and photography of the events. It is realized that no prior permission for the use of drones had been taken by the event organizers.

Whereas, inputs have been received by intelligence agencies about the possibility of attacks by terrorists /anti -social elements through Para -Gliders Remote Controlled Drones, Remote Controlled Micro -Light Aircraft, etc., and there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life, health safety and damage to public property on that account.

There is need to keep a check and regulate the activities of Terrorists / Antisocial elements around the Commissionerate limits to prevent the attack through Remote Controlled Drones or through Para - Gliders or through Remote Controlled Micro -Light Aircraft.

Therefore I, Mahesh M. Bhagwat, IPS, Commissioner of Police Rachakonda. In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 144 of the Criminal procedure code 1973 (Act II of 1974), **do here by order that no flying activities of drone controlled by remote or through control area missile or using Para - Gliders or through Remote Control Micro - Light Aircraft be allowed in the Commissionerate limits without prior police permission in writing .**

No Non-Govt. agency, organization or individual will be allowed to launch Remotely Controlled Drones or Para-Gliders or Remotely Controlled Micro-Light Aircraft, Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) / Unmanned Aerial Survey (UAS) in

Rachakonda Police Commissionerate limits without prior written permission till further orders in the interest of public safety and security.

Government agencies and organizations should obtain appropriate clearance from local police and aviation authorities before launching any UAS /UAV for any purpose.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code 1860.

This order will remain in force in the limits of Rachakonda Police Commissionerate unless withdrawn.
