### FAKE JOB RACKET BUSTED BY SOT, RACHAKONDA - QUARTET HELD

Four people belonging one gang were arrested on the charge of running a fake job racket and cheating unemployed youth, by promising employment in central and state government departments.

Acting on information, the sleuths of Special Operations Team, LB Nagar Zone, Rachakonda Commissionerate arrested the four people and found they had indulged in cheating job-seekers after taking an advance 5 lakh from each candidate. The gang had issued fake appointment orders and training letters to the youth.

#### Brief Facts:-

The modus operandi of the gang was to tell unemployed youth through their friends and relatives about jobs in various departments, including railways and demanding Rs 16 lakh and collecting Rs. 5 lakhs as advance from each candidate to secure positions in them.

They used to send fake emails and call letters after obtaining the advance from the candidates, asking them to report at their respective departments. The release further said after issuing fake appointment letters of railways and forged signatures and cheated the youth.

The accused had collected ₹ 8 lakhs from duo for providing employment in Railways and took them to Delhi on the name training programme. Further, they are in hunt of new candidate who is searching for the job, the unemployed youth who approached the gang got suspicion of their activities and informed the police. Following a complaint by the victim, the police nabbed all the four accused. The accused persons along with seized material were handed over to SHO, Chaitanyapuri police for further action.
