APPREHENDED TWO CATTLE THEFT OFFENDERS AND RECOVERED CASH Rs. 5,00,000/-, (2) MOBILE PHONES, TWO PASSENGER AUTOS, TWO BIKES WHICH WERE USED IN THE COMMISSION OF OFFENCES ALL WORTH RS. 9,00,000/- FROM THEIR POSSESSION.

The sleuths of CCS L.B. Nagar along with Kandukur Police of Rachakonda Police Commissionerate have made sincere efforts and today i.e. on 28.11.2018 at 05.00 hrs apprehended cattle theft offenders by names 1) Vislavath Bajender S/o Ramulu, age: 28 years, Occ: Agriculture, R/o Pothubanda Thanda, Kandukur (M), Ranga Reddy dist., and 2) Rathlavath Chinna S/o Somla age: 25 years, Occ: Auto Driver R/o Matike Thanda, Devarkonda (M), Nalgonda dist., under suspicious circumstances at Dabbedaguda Gate, Kandukur on questioning them they revealed their criminal record and confessed the following offences.

Recently series of cattle theft offence taken place specially sheeps and goats under the limits Ibrahimpatnam division of Rachakonda Commissionerate. The Commissioner of Police, Rachakonda formed a special team under the supervision of Addl. DCP Crimes led by K.Shiva Shankar, Inspector of Police and team i.e., PC-4870 of Kandukur PS, PC 6082 of Yacharam PS & PC 6124 Manchal PS for apprehension of cattle theft offenders. The special team made sincere efforts and apprehended the cattle theft gang within a short period.

MODUS OPERANDI (MO) - The accused **A-1 Vislavath Bajender** is resident of Pothubanda Thanda, Kandukur (M), Ranga Reddy dist living along with his family by doing agriculture cultivation in his village. He was habituated to luxurious life and discontinued agriculture work. In this connection there was disputes arises between wife and husband. So in order to meet his lavish expenditure he started cattle theft offences along with his friend **A-2 Rathlavath Chinna** is a auto driver of his close relative.

The **A-1 Vislavath Bajender** used to reccee during evening hours at flocks which are away outskirts of villages and guardless and he used to upload the Google location in Whatsapp. During night time Bajender went recceed places on his bike, if shepherd found absence he will commit theft of sheeps or goats by plastering mouth and by tying legs. After that he use to intimate the same to **A-2 Rathlavath Chinna** by sharing Google location. On that the A-2 proceeded to the location by his passenger auto, then both put the sheeps and goats in auto and flees away from spot. While they were moving from the spot the A-1 pilots auto on his bike and the A2 followed by him, if any police checking found on the way they will change their regular route and moves in a new routes by using "Google Maps" in his mobile phone to avoid police checking. They used to change bike and auto to hide their identification from villagers and police. Thereafter they dumped the stolen sheeps and goats in interior area nearby Mallepally faire by tied mouth and legs with plaster. Then they sold the stolen sheep or goats at cheaper rate on Sunday public faire at Mallapally and Thukguda area.

Under the direct supervision and of **Sri Mahesh M Bhagwat, Commissioner of Police, Rachakonda**, with the guidance of Sri K.R Nagaraj DCP Crimes and Sri D. Srinivas Addl. DCP Crimes CCS LB Nagar and team has apprehended the offenders and detected **(7) Cases** all worth of Rs. **9,00,000/-** In this case.
