Coordination meeting conducted with 200 pharma company representatives & stake holders to sort out issues related to 24x7 manufacturing, supply of raw material and distribution of bulk drugs in Rachakonda police Commissionerate.

Today Commissioner of Police, Rachakonda, Sri Mahesh Bhagwat IPS, conducted a joint Co-Ordination meeting at Shubham Convention, Nagole with Sri Harish IAS, Jt. Collector Ranga Reddy Dist. Sri Narsimha Reddy Executive Director of Industries of T.S., District Industries Officer Yadadri Bhongiri, Sri Krupanand Pollution Control Board Official, Sri Sathish General Secretary Rachakonda Security Council, Sri Sudheer Babu IPS Addl. CP Rachakonda and DCPs Yadari Bhongiri, LB Nagar and Malkajgiri Zones, ACPs, SHOs and about (140) Pharmaceutical Company owners / Representatives attended the meeting from 4 PM to 5.30 PM to discuss the problems facing by the Pharmaceutical companies during the lock down period while manufacturing and supplying the medicines 24x7.

In the meeting the CP Rachakonda has addressed by stating that the police department and other concerned departments are available for 24x7 to facilitate the Pharmaceutical companies to run their companies without any interruption, by which the people may not face any shortage of medicine during the Corona lock down period. CP has requested the Pharmaceutical management to bring their problems to the notice of concerned to solve them.

Regarding the problems raised by the Pharmaceutical Companies that the supply of Raw material should not be stopped and its prices should be under control, transportation of employees from their residence to the companies, calling of the employees who went to their native places, some of the Flat owners not allowing the staff to go out from the flats and also requested to allow their staff/worker to go for work on producing their company ID cards.

In this regard Commissioner of Police Rachakonda and other Government officials assured them to sort out their problems. Many pharma representatives has interacted and thanked Officials for redressal of their grievances.
