

PRESS RELEASE

On 29.09.2017 at 1900 hrs received a complaint of Sri Igor Boldyrev S/o Gennady, aged 35 yrs, Occ: Second Secretary Vice - Counsel, C/o Embassy of the Russian Federation in India, Shanthipath, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi-110021, in which he stated that in the month of May - 2016 the Embassy of the Russian Federation of India had approached the Indian Hyderabad - based company M/s KRB - GEIO Services, located at B-26, 1st floor, Huda Colony, Saroornagar, Hyderabad for which Kore Ranga Babu s/o Pedda Rangaiah, age,54, R/o H.no.30-551,Markapuram Road, Guntur District is the CEO seeking to purchase an electronic equipment necessary for construction works at the Embassy premises SIR 3000 Ground Penetrating Radar with 270 MHz antenna and 400 MHz antenna at New-Delhi. Upon confirmation of availability of the said equipment with that company, the Embassy paid the entire amount of US Dollars 42,500 through bank transfer.

However, despite repeated requests through phone conversations, SMS and e-mails with the accused Mr. Ranga Babu CEO of M/s KRB - GEIO Services, neither delivered the said equipment nor refunded the amount to the Embassy. Upon which a case in Crime No. 702/2018 U/Sec 420, 406 IPC was registered at Saroornagar PS, Rachakonda and investigated into.

Under the supervision and the guidance of Sri. Mahesh M. Bhagwat, I.P.S., Commissioner of Police, Rachakonda, and under the directions of Sri M. Venkateshwar Rao, Dy. Commissioner of Police, L.B Nagar Zone and Sri Venugopal Rao former Asst. Commissioner of Police, Sri K. Pruthvidhar Rao, Asst. Commissioner of Police, L.B Nagar Division, the then Inspector of Police Sri. Biksam Reddy and Present Inspector of Police Sri. NCH Rangaswamy, Sub-Inspector of Police, N.Jayaram and PCO 5009 H. Kumar of Saroornagar PS, had made sincere and strenuous efforts to recover the amount from Mr. Ranga Babu CEO of M/s KRB - GEIO Services, resulting which the company authorities had remitted the entire amounts to the Embassy on installment basis through bank transfer. The good work done by the IO was appreciated by the Russian Federation Embassy officials too.
