Key Guidelines:

CCTV Surveillance

Install high-definition (HD) CCTV cameras at home entrances, inside premises, gates, and facing main roads.

Cameras should have night vision features.

Ensure integration of these CCTV systems with the Police Command & Control Room.

Alarm Systems

Equip doors and windows with sensor-based alarm systems.

Alarms should trigger immediately upon any suspicious movement or forced entry.

Use strong grills and reliable locks on all entry points.

Neighbourhood Cooperation

Maintain good relations with neighbours and support each other during absences from home.

Report suspicious individuals or vehicles to the police without delay.

Professional Security

Hire professional security guards if required.

Engage only trusted and reliable security service providers.

Lighting Arrangements

Ensure there are no dark, unlit areas around residences.

Use motion-sensor lighting to further strengthen security.

Social Media Caution

Do not share travel plans or extended absences from home on social media platforms.

The Commissioner stated that adherence to these measures will significantly help in preventing thefts and robberies. He appealed to residents to strictly follow the guidelines and extend full cooperation to the police.
